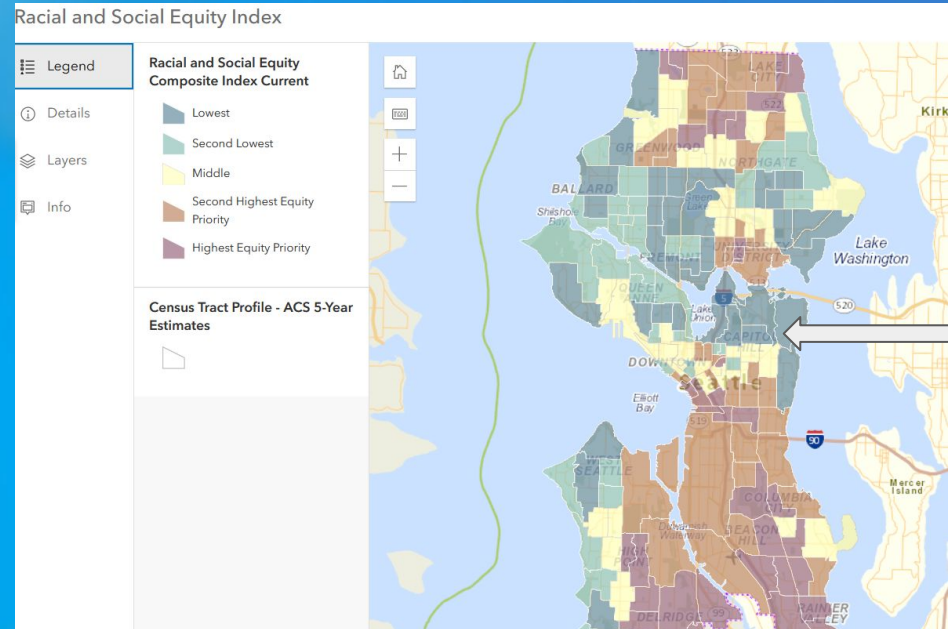

“The Racial and Social Equity Index combines information on race, ethnicity, and related demographics with data on socioeconomic and health disadvantages to identify where priority populations make up relatively large proportions of neighborhood residents.”¹

Original Weighted Lottery

- Format:
 - Google Forms with Applications Exported to Spreadsheet
 - Running the Lottery:
 1. Assign each applicant a number according their row on the spreadsheet
 2. Categorize each child's zip code according to the Racial and Social Equity Index
 3. Make a separate spreadsheet of children who meet weighted lottery criteria along the following guidelines:
 - Racial and Social Equity Index Category
 - Referral
 - Financial Aid or Subsidy
- Initial offers (20% of total spots) are made just to these students on that spreadsheet.

New Intake Information

Licensed School

- Accepting more subsidies

Schedule

- Early Care 1-5 days/week
- Afternoon Late Care
- Families applying for Early Care and Late Care rank their need for this service
 - High
 - Medium
 - Low



Updated Weighted Lottery











- Format:
 - Ideal Logic Registration System with filter options
- Running the Lottery:
 1. Categorize each child's zip code according to the Racial and Social Equity Index.
 2. Filter according to the weighted lottery factors- Index Category, Referral, Financial Aid or **Subsidy Need, Schedule Preference.**
 3. By using these filters, offer 20% of spots to children who meet the weighted lottery criteria.

Timing	Re-evaluation	Support Goals
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Understand the timeline for subsidy families.- Hold a few spots for summer or assisted enrollment.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Referrals should include teachers. Referrals just from OT or PT offices support families who have resources.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Support families once they're enrolled- small tours, social stories.- Training teachers on diversity in curriculum, supporting parents with trauma, and other inclusive practices.- As members of the nature preschool field, increase the diversity of the teaching teams.
