
The Frazer Center fosters inclusive communities where children and adults, with and without disabilities, gather, learn, and flourish.











Frazer Center Child Development Program

- Full-day, full-year child care & early learning, ages 0-5
- Summer camp, ages 5-8
- Licensed, Quality Rated
- 189 children*
- 20% with disabilities/delays, 80% typically-developing
- Inclusion Coaches support teachers and ensure continuity in planning and intervention for children with disabilities, linking classroom, therapy, and home
- Therapists are on-site embedded into the program
- Frazer Center Nature-Based Curriculum & Creative Curriculum





Frazer Center's early education program welcomes the full and meaningful inclusion of children with disabilities and developmental delays. Children in our Inclusion Program are not just present in the classroom. They are meaningfully engaged with their classmates in learning and play.






